Moreton Bay Regional Council is developing a Neighbourhood Plan for Kallangur-Dakabin.

A Community Reference Group (CRG) will provide local knowledge and input on a range of matters in the Kallangur-Dakabin Neighbourhood Plan area to help Council set a vision for the area and strategies to help us get there.
