[00:00:01] Moreton Bay Regional Council are working on plans to upgrade the Morayfield Skate Park, and we need your help to make sure the design is unique and caters to the local community. Before starting the design we held an online survey to ask the community what they would like the redeveloped facility to look like. And we had over 160 responses full of awesome feedback, which we've used to shape the design. Based on community feedback and our assessment of the existing skate parks condition.

[00:00:33] It has been determined the existing skate park requires demolishing and replacing. This is due to many safety hazards, poor structural condition and an outdated design. We're planning to replace the existing facility with a contemporary skate park that meets the needs of current and future skate park uses.

[00:00:53] The concept design is now at a stage where you can see what we came up with and tell us what you think.

[00:00:58] The new regional skate park will cater to skate park uses of all ages and skill levels, as well as providing family friendly space that is inviting for spectators and the wider community. The first zone is an intermediate level bowl, which is built around a central island, the main section of the bowl will be four foot, or one point two meters deep, with extensions and features around the bowl.

[00:01:36] The intermediate bowl links into an open mini bowl, which provides a mini ramp similar to the size of the existing skate parks mini ramp. The mini bowl opens into the long, flat and open street area, offering well Space Street style obstacles to avoid the area feeling crowded. The Street area works with a long bank to ledge on one side and more technical obstacles on the other side. Quarter pipes at either end of the street area allow for long continuous runs.

[00:02:19] The existing vert ramp will be relocated and positioned in front of a new spectator seating area. To create an inviting and family friendly facility, we've included a large central shade shelter with plenty of seating.

[00:02:32] providing a great vantage point to hang out. An access path through the facility allows pedestrians to safely reach the seating areas, and the existing shelter will be retained and renovated to tie in with the new skate park. We've also included bins and drinking fountains. Sports level lighting will be included to allow safe skate park to use in the evenings.
