Moreton Bay Regional Council kicked off our Morayfield Neighbourhood Plan project by asking the community what they love about the Morayfield area and what Council should focus on as the area grows and develops.

We received more than 200 survey responses and 190 pins on our online map. We also interacted with over 400 people across 14 pop-up displays. Thank you to everyone who got involved and took the time to share your views and ideas about your neighbourhood.



#### Why a Community Reference Group?

A CRG is a group of people who have an interest in Caboolture South, Morayfield and Upper Caboolture, such as a business owner, property owner or someone who works or lives in the area. They will provide local knowledge and input on a range of matters in the Morayfield Neighbourhood Plan area to help Council set a vision for the area and strategies to help us get there.

#### Specifically, the CRG will:

- receive briefings on the purpose and process of neighbourhood
- advocate, promote and facilitate the flow of information between community and Council
- work closely with Council to ensure community concerns and aspirations are understood and considered
- provide advice and innovation to help formulate solutions to contribute to Council decisions
- monitor and represent community views regarding local issues



#### **Neighbourhood Plan Steps**
