

DAYBORO PARK UPGRADE

COMMUNITY CONSULTATION - OUTCOMES AT A GLANCE

The collaborative process focused on working with the local community and traders of Dayboro to unpack what makes the town unique and well-loved by the people who live and work there, as well as capturing their ideas and aspirations for the parks future design.

An overview of engagement outcomes have been captured below.

What is your one big idea for Roderick A Cruice Park?

- Playground that is appropriate for all ages. Suggestions to incorporate flying fox, slide + see-saw.
- Water park or splash park.
- Fenced play area.
- Accessible play equipment including a disability friendly swing.
- Showcase history through signage, creative elements + planting inc First Nations history.
- Stage, amphitheatre or rotunda.
- Open grassed space for picnics + events.
- Community garden.
- Events + activities inc music or movies under the stars + night markets.
- Landscaping inc native planting.
- Sensory gardens, walking track including trees + flowering shrubs and botanical garden.
- Games + activities inc mini-golf or obstacle course.
- Horse / animal paddock + hitching rails to tie horses.
- More parking.
- Shade inc more trees and a cover for all weather markets.
- Improved skatepark + pump track.
- Rentable artist + maker spaces.
- Improved amenities inc picnic tables, seating, bins, bubbler, toilets + BBQs.
- Exercise equipment.
- Fix the level + drainage.
- Family friendly.
- Sand area.
- Improved accessibility in and around the park inc paths through the space.
- Attract wildlife inc native bees, frogs + birds.
- Local art inc timber carvings + sculptures.
- Upgrade the pool.
- Improved lighting.
- Don't make it overly structured or urbanised.
- Dog friendly
