Moreton Bay Regional Council is developing a Neighbourhood Plan for Morayfield.

A Community Reference Group (CRG) will provide local knowledge and input on a range of matters in the Morayfield area to help Council set a vision for the area and strategies to help us get there.

Expressions of interest to join the CRG were invited between Tuesday 19th April 2022 until Monday 30th May 2022. When forming a CRG, Council aims for members to contain a broad cross-section of the community, to endeavour to bring together a range of interests and needs.
